BUNINYONG GOLF CLUB WOMEN'S GOLDEN PUTTER – CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The entry fee (\$60 per pair) is to be paid at the time of entry. Refunds possible in exceptional circumstances or if seven days' notice is provided. Cart hire to be paid with entry fee.
2. Pairs entering the BGC Golden Putter event need not be from the same club.
3. The event is open to female amateur golfers who are members of a golf club affiliated with Golf Victoria and/or who have an official handicap. The Match Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to provide a reason.
4. In the event of a tie, the winners will be decided by a Golf Australia countback.
5. The event will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R & A Rules together with such local rules in force on the day of play. If a dispute arises it shall be addressed by the BGC Match Committee whose decision will be final. Pace of play: Players are encouraged to adhere to pace of play rules (Rules 6-7). In addition, players are required to adhere to Golf Victoria's Code of Conduct during this event.
6. The Match Committee shall make arrangements for the event and may if need arises, vary arrangements and/or conditions.
7. Mobile phones may be carried on the course but must be turned off or to silent and used only to contact the club house for rules queries or in an emergency.
8. Handicapping of this event will be enacted as per GA recommendations.
9. During and after the event players may have the opportunity to have their photograph taken, to highlight the event on BGC website or promote women's golf. Any player not wishing to have their photograph taken or published merely needs to decline the offer at the time or inform BGC that they do not wish their image and details to be published.
10. Draw for this event will be published on the Buninyong Golf Club website.
11. Competition conditions and catering arrangements may require altering in line with current Covid regulations at time of competition.

12. Players must be fully vaccinated in line with Government Regulations to participate in this event and show proof on arrival at the course.
